Electronic Lien and Title (ELT) Lender Application

This application form is to be used by financial institutions to enroll or modify an existing account in the Iowa Department of Transportation's (DOT) Electronic Lien and Title (ELT) Program.

Instructions for use:

- Lenders must complete Sections A and B, then forward this form to the selected provider.
- The provider named in Section B must complete Section C and submit this completed application to the Iowa DOT.
- All sections must be completed prior to submission to the Iowa DOT
- Lenders must establish a service relationship with one of DOT's approved providers for transmission of all vehicle and title data.

By signing above Participating Lenders agree to the following conditions and requirements:

- The lender must provide the ELT Identifier assigned by the Iowa DOT to all loan recipients and dealers utilizing the lender services. The lender must require that all loan recipients and dealers utilizing lender services properly record the ELT Identifier on the Iowa Application for Notation of Security Interest, form 411046, and/or the Application for Certificate of Title and/or Registration, form 411007, in addition to any other lienholder information required to be disclosed.
- The lender must work directly with their chosen provider to resolve all ELT discrepancies and data transmission issues.
- The lender shall protect the confidentiality of the information and data to which lender has access. At no time shall the lender furnish to any person, association or organization any vehicle or title data received from the Iowa DOT without the Iowa DOT's prior written consent.
- The lender has no proprietary rights to the information received from the Iowa DOT.
- The lender understands that the Iowa DOT and its employees shall not be liable to the lender for any damage, costs, lost production or any other loss of any kind for failure of the Iowa DOT's equipment hardware or software or for the loss of consequential damages that are the result of any other type of failure.
- Either party, upon giving 30 days written notice to the other party, may terminate authorization. In the event of termination, Iowa DOT is released from any and all obligations to the lender.
